Initially all new stallholders are classified as Casual.

In normal circumstance fees are:

Casual Stall - \$125 Hot Food/Coffee - \$150

In the current circumstance stall fee have been reduced to:

Casual Stall - \$95 Hot Food/Coffee - \$100

Minimum initial booking for consideration as a vendor is 4 consecutive markets. Stall fees must be prepaid for the next two markets upon acceptance of your application.

- Electricity (where available) + \$20
- Application processing fee \$25

Note: To be classified as a permanent stallholder, and retain that classification, you must attend **at least 6 consecutive markets and 12 markets in a calendar year.**

Permanent stallholder's fees are normally \$95; \$115 with electricity, if available.

Currently, the fees are \$85; \$105 with electricity, if available.

A \$20 late fee will be added to invoices not paid in a timely manner.

Stall fees are non refundable.

Insurance

Stallholders are obliged to have public liability insurance. On approval, the stallholder must provide TBM with copies of Certificates of Currency for Australia Wide public liability in the sum of \$20 million. It is also recommended that you have insurance for your product. If you currently do not have public liability insurance and are approved to trade at the Market, you may elect to be covered by the TBM public liability insurance at a cost of \$25 per market.
