Minimum initial booking for consideration as a vendor is 3 consecutive markets. Stall fees must be prepaid for two markets upon acceptance of your application.

Electricity (where available) + \$10

**Note:** To be classified as a permanent stallholder, and retain the same space at each market, you must attend at least 6 consecutive markets and 9 markets in a calendar year.

Permanent stallholder's fees are \$95 and \$125 for hot food + electricity if required.
